Another wonderful year with our Juliena campers! Plenty of fun in the sun, artwork, popsicles, and pool time! Be sure to sign up for camp again in 2020!



GOABLE is a two-day development program for young Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing ladies from all over Georgia in October of 2020. The young women will participate in the leadership program which offers activities and workshops facilitated by Deaf female leaders. Eligible applicants are dynamic youths who are Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing between the ages 14 and 18 and are enrolled in high school.

GCDHH's next ASL course will begin on January 25th, 2019. The deadline to register is January 17th. The course fee is \$80/student. A textbook is required for all courses. For ASL 1 students, the textbook fee is \$40. For ASL 2-4 students, the textbook fee is \$80.
