Clarity XLC2+

The XLC2+ is a cordless amplified telephone that can digitally amplify up to 50 decibels and has 3 tone settings. It includes a talking caller ID that announces the phone number of the incoming call and has large, illuminated buttons that speak which number is being pushed. It has a loud, flashing ringer and is hearing aid compatible.

This phone is ideal for someone with moderate to severe hearing loss, low mobility, limited speech, and/or low vision. It is simpler than the XLC3.4+ with less buttons but cannot have any other handsets added.

Clarity XLCgo

The XLCgo is an amplifier designed to pair with your cell phone. It is a wireless amplifier that can be taken around with you to hear phone calls from your cell phone using an extra loud amplifier that goes up to 50 decibels, tone control, and large easy to see buttons. This device can be taken with you out of the house to hear calls from your cellphone using a more powerful speaker, and includes a belt clip, lanyard, and car air vent holder so that you can always have it in a convenient location.

This amplifier is ideal for someone who uses their cell phone often and wants to be able to amplify their calls while they are on the go.

Clarity XLC3.4+

The XLC3.4+ is similar to the XLC2+ with digital amplification up to 50 decibels, large, illuminated buttons, and an extra loud, flashing ringer. It also has a digital screen that displays the number calling in a large font. With the XLC3.4+, you can add up to 3 extra handsets to place around your home.

This phone is ideal for someone with moderate to severe hearing loss, low mobility, limited speech, and/or low vision. It has a digital screen where you can read the caller ID and connect up to 3 more handsets.
